There is nothing wrong with simplicity, in fact simple lyrics are accessible lyrics – but simple-minded lyrics seem to be the norm in today's popular music.

Matt learned to play guitar by picking up a Pete Seeger Banjo book and a Mel Bay book of chords so he could accompany his father. The Crawdad Song, This Land Is Your Land, Blowing In The Wind, and other tunes formed the basis for his love for acoustic music.

"My mom says I would run around singing 'Sunshine Go Away Today' just so I could shout the word 'Damned!'. I still love music for that freedom.
